## PRESIDENT'S REPORT

This year past has seen many wonderful achievements for the club and without doubt the highlight of these was the club's success at the Australian Club Championships with both the men's and women's teams winning the titles in Hobart to make a historic double for the club.

In Shield competition we enjoyed continued success with Box Hill again winning the men's Division one competition to make it the seventh year in a row that Box Hill has been the premier club in the leading men's competition in Victoria. We are also fortunate to have a very strong team in the U16 Men who also came away with a shield victory in a convincing manner.

At the Eastern Region finals, Box Hill also won 4 premierships in the Men's Division 1 & 2 and U16 and the Womens U18. It bodes well for the future potential of the club in having such strong under age teams and we hope that these young athletes continue on in the sport so they can fulfil their potential.

Many thanks to the team managers Rob Falkenberg, David Boyd, Cathy Tilley and Elissa Ward for their assistance and encouragement to the athletes throughout the year, which is a large part of the reason why our teams continue to enjoy success.

At the Australian championships our medallists included, Dora Spathis who won a silver medal as the 2nd Australian in the Heptathlon, Rosie Ditton who cleared 4.20m to win a bronze medal in the pole vault ahead of Melanie Adams who finished 4th and in the men's pole vault, James Filshie, who jumped a PB of 5.25m to also grab a bronze while Joel Pocklington came 4th. Daniel Clark ran a personal best of 3:45.8 in his heat of the 1500m at the nationals held in Brisbane.

There were numerous athletes who achieved success in the Victorian Champs with 8 golds, 3 silver, 8 bronze amongst club our members. At the National Cross Country Championships Chris Hamer defended his national under 20 cross country championship in Perth.

Our club captains Rosanna Ditton and David Featherstone showed leadership both on and off the track over the past season and were a fine example to younger athletes. Rosie continued her high level of performance, competing across Australia at an elite level in the pole vault and David was awarded the outstanding finals athlete award for his inspirational efforts.

Our track redevelopment is finally complete with a full reconstruction of the base, a new surface, a 10 lane front straight and dual long and triple jump runways. Thank you to all who endured the inconvenience of alternative training and competition arrangements during the construction period, but now we have a facility to be truly proud of and one which will attract athletes as a high quality training and competition venue.

During the past year the club was saddened by the passing of Rob Ward, Richard Rancie, Dot Cook and Rod Fraser. Our thoughts are with those closely affected by these events.

On a brighter note Club Life Member, Harry Summers, was awarded a 50 Year Service Award by Athletics Victoria in recognition of reaching 50 years membership of Athletics Victoria. This is a truly incredible dedication to the sport.

The annual Trivia Night was again a great success with about 200 people attending and helping to raise in excess of \$5,000. Many thanks to Leana Tilley and her team of enthusiastic volunteers who assisted in making this night such a great success.

Our registration numbers dropped slightly over the past year to 191 competing athletes down from 201 in the previous year and we hope to improve both our recruitment and retention of members for the coming year.

Barbara Johnson has assisted with the ongoing operation of the committee as minutes secretary and efficiently distributing the hardcopy newsletters. Vivienne Lee promptly performed the role of Registrar enabling all our athletes to compete and Joan Hines never tires in her role of managing the venue committee and ensuring the efficient conduct of competition, seamlessly guiding officials that unfortunately are often too few and taken for granted by some competitors.

The Club has again had a successful year financially, recording a strong surplus and finally paying off our loan for the club room redevelopment, although unfortunately as we get out of one debt we are preparing to go into another to fund our contribution to the new track.

## TREASURER'S REPORT

After a minus result last financial year the Club has been able to claw its way back to a net surplus of \$35,541.72. This is an excellent result and has been achieved by:

- Ensuring all athletes pay membership fees or training fees
- An increase in ground hirings
- An increase in donations and
- An increase in fund raising activities.

The first instalment for the track redevelopment of \$12,100 has been paid to the City of Whitehorse. Taking this payment into account the actual net profit before capital works expenditure was approximately \$47,000

Whilst ground hiring was increased, membership decreased. This is a worrying factor and all efforts should be made to recruit new members to the club.

It is important to note that the Bank loan was repaid in full during the last financial year however a new loan of \$100,000 has been taken out with the Commonwealth Bank to refund the final payment to the City of Whitehorse for the track redevelopment. Once the monies are drawn down and paid to the Council a tight rein will need to be kept on expenditure so that the club can meet the monthly repayments of approximately \$1,700.

Many donations were made direct to the Club or through the Barlow Fund and I thank all members who contributed in this way.

Approximately \$9,600 was raised through fundraising activities, which included the 75th Year Dinner and Trivia Night. Both these events were a huge success. Thanks to all members who chipped in and helped with fundraising activities.

The Club this season has again been run by a small Committee with a new President, Colin Organ. I would like to thank Colin and all members of the Committee for their support and hard work during the season. It is necessary for each committee member to take on a specific role and to recruit more committee members so that the workload can be distributed evenly.

### Women

The highlight for the women's team in the 2007-2008 season was the inaugural success at the Australian club championships where despite only a small team of 8 travelling to Hobart, some terrific multi event performances enabled a surprise win to combine with the men's successful team in a historic double for the club.

While athlete numbers were down slightly on the previous year with a lower women's membership and a poor retention rate, the women managed to qualify 3 teams in the association finals with the Division 1 team finishing 6<sup>th</sup>, Under 18 women finishing a close 4<sup>th</sup> and the Under 14 team in 6<sup>th</sup> position. At the shield finals the stand out performance was the Under 18 women's team winning in a convincing manner by almost 100 points, while the Division 1 women's team performed well despite a number of team members being unavailable to

### **Men's Shield report**

The 2007/2008 Shield season saw all the Box Hill men's teams get away to a flying start. For the first time in many years we had the division 3 and 4 teams well placed in the top four on the ladder. This was mainly due to a good number of athletes competing early in the season which helped push numbers down into the lower grades. Sadly for us this did not continue for the whole season and come finals time we had our all-conquering division 1 team on top and our division 2 team safely in 4th place. We kept the pressure on Division 3 and 4 all season but just failed to make the finals in these two divisions. There was some outstanding improvement in some events this season, none more so than the 1500m. It has been a long time since we have had runners breaking 3:50 but this season we regularly had several runners going under this time. This event is quite pivotal in that if you have good performers at this distance then these boys will also run well at 800m and/or 3000m. Our sprinting stocks are going through a change of face at the moment, so a lot was put on the shoulders of Rhett Medford, Mohammad Zeed and Cameron Sherry. Coupled with the brilliance of Josh Ross and the emergence of Andrew Haddow, Moses Levey and David Burke, it is hoped that we will see our sprinting strength hold the dominant ground that we have enjoyed over the past few years.

Our throwing results were very solid this season. Sam Scherma and the ever-reliable Chris Ruddy did a great job for us at the top end while also enjoying good backup from Dave Featherston and Brett Nuske.

The area where we do need some more competitors is in the horizontal jumps and walk events.

The shield season ended with some very exciting finals. A comfortable win in Division 1 at both the Region and Shield final kept this team's unbeaten record in shield finals intact since its inception 4 years ago. This result coupled with victory in the Australian Club Championships in January meant that Box Hill continues to be the pace setter for athletics in this country. Division 2 had a nail biting draw with SSH in the region final only to lose on a count back and then was placed second in the Shield final, well clear of the third and fourth teams.

Enormous credit goes to all the competitors that contributed throughout the year and to our finals success. The following athletes played a significant role in Box Hill staying number one in the Men's competition.

### **Junior Men**

During the 2006/07 season, Box Hill fielded Junior Male teams in the Under 16 and Under 18 competitions. A very large participation rate in the Under 16s made it necessary to enter a second team in this competition.

Unfortunately, in contrast to the Under 16s, the numbers in the Under 18s was down on previous seasons. Even so, the efforts put by the Under 18 athletes saw the team managing to keep in touch with the final four for most of the season, and were always a chance to make finals right up until about round nine. The team finished the season in seventh place on the ladder.

The Under 16s dominated a 13 team competition, winning most rounds and finishing on top of the ladder by a margin of 17 points. The second Under 16s team was only included into the competition from round four, but gradually moved up the ladder to finish in ninth place.

The venue final for the Under 16s was contested between Box Hill (1st Place), Ringwood (2nd), Diamond Valley (3rd) and St. Kevins (4th). Even though they only finished in fourth position, St. Kevins looked like they were going to be the main competition (they had actually managed to beat Box Hill in the last couple of the rounds leading up to the final). However a large turnout for the final saw Box Hill under 16s dominate and run out easy victors.

Similarly in the Shield Final, another strong turnout saw Box Hill under 16s dominate and take out the premiership by a large margin from our main rivals, Knox. On a disappointing note there was much confusion with the scoring. At various stages we were shown as being well behind and well in front, and many of the boys went home not knowing for sure what the final result was.

Next year should see a large number of Under 16s move up to Under 18s and bolster that age group. This will still leave many younger Under 16s available to defend the premiership won this year. Plus any new athletes coming into the system will further bolster our teams. So things are looking promising for the Junior Male teams next year.

## 2007 WINTER REPORT

Box Hill teams performed consistently throughout the 2007 winter season with some fine individual performances, however we did not enjoy the same level of team success as we have enjoyed in recent seasons.

Undoubtedly, the highlight for the year was the success of the men's Under 20 team who comfortably won the winter premiership while still filling half of our Division 1 men's relay teams. On top of this team success, Chris Hamer won the National Under 20 cross country championship for the second year in a row, finished second at Sandown and Yarra Bend and third at Geelong; Matt Coloe finished second at Latrobe Uni and third at Sandown and Steve Kelly finished third at Latrobe Uni. With these athletes all moving up to senior competition next season, it is hoped that they will be able to continue on their steady improvement of recent years and help our Division 1 team challenge for the winter premiership - which we have been unable to win for over 30 years.

The senior mens' teams performed consistently throughout the season with Division 1 gaining a number of third placings and finishing second in the Burnley Half Marathon. The Division 3 team won several races, however it was disappointing that we were unable to fill our second team at Latrobe Uni and Geelong and the team was disqualified in the Coliban Relay which meant that we just missed out on promotion to Division 2. Andrew White was our most consistent runner during the year with three top 10 finishes, while Daniel Clark improved steadily during the year with a best performance of 8th at Yarra Bend.

The number of women competing during the winter dropped off from previous years, particularly in the junior teams, however there were some fine individual performances by several runners.

Hayley Tomlinson showed a welcome return to fitness to win the Under 20 races at Sandown and Geelong and finish second at Latrobe University and Yarra Bend. Jocelyn Keage was our most consistent senior athlete, running every race during the season to be the mainstay of our women's team, while Amanda Harper also performed consistently through the year and had the Club's best individual placing, finishing 14th in the Burnley Half Marathon. Rachel Johnson was unfortunately injured for the first half of the season, but made a welcome return to racing in the second half of the season with some good performances.

The winter athletes are greatly indebted to Chris O'Connor who does a fantastic job of organising teams, arranging race entries, chasing up athletes, assisting with provision of afternoon tea after the races and producing a weekly email bulletin to keep the whole Club informed about upcoming events and recent race results. Many thanks are also due to Ian Sloane for assisting with team management duties, preparing comprehensive race reports after each race and once again setting handicap marks for the increasingly popular 5 km Handicap race at the start of the season; to Megan Sloane for providing afternoon tea; and to Julie Milner for assisting with officiating and transporting the Club tent to and from each race. Without the support from these people, the Club would not have experienced the successes, which we have enjoyed over the past year.
