CROSS COUNTRY RELAYS – THIS SATURDAY!

The first big event for the year is the is the AV cross country relay competition. This year the relays will be held at **Yarra Bend** on this **Saturday**, **April 30**. (Yarra Bend Park - Melway 44 H2 or D2 E5).

The race start times are:

Open Men and Women, Under 20 Men: 1:30 pm

All other junior teams: 2:00 pm.

Please make sure that you are at the course at least 45 minutes prior to the start of your race so that you have a chance to collect your numbers and get warmed up prior to running.

To take part in the cross country relays, you must be registered for the 2005/2006 season either before or on the day of competition.

We are planning to enter at least 3 men's and 2 women's teams in the open competition (6km) as well as under 20, under 18 and under 16 teams (6km for under 20 men, 3km for all others) so please let the winter competition committee know of your availability as soon as possible so that teams can be organised.

We are hoping to have as many runners as possible there to start the season off on a winning note.

Helpers! We also need help from people who are not competing, especially on relay day, so please let us know if you can help with time keeping or other organisational duties.
