SANDOWN 10KM ROAD RACE ON SATURDAY MAY, 28

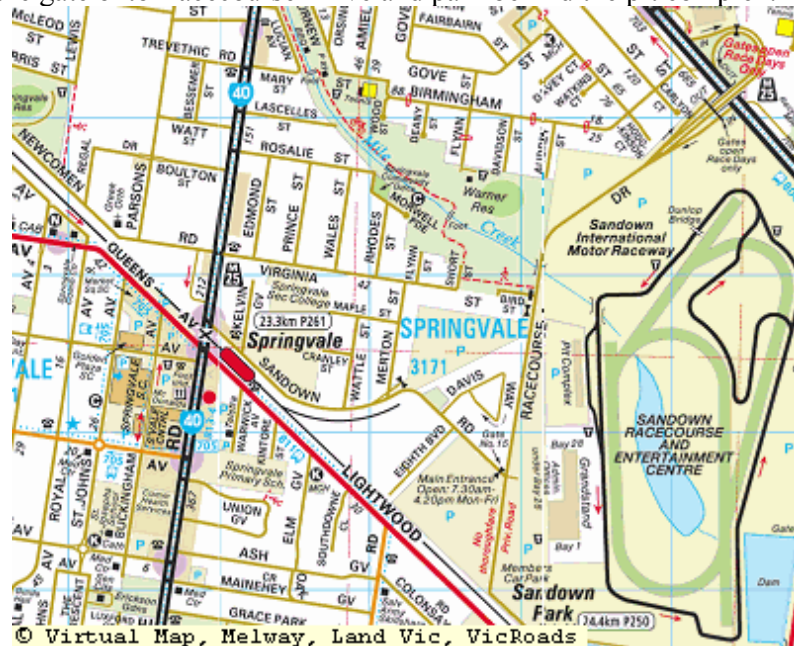
At Bendigo our division 1 men finished a close 2nd to Glenhuntly and our women's team, who are competing in division 2 this year, were clear winners.
