# **NATIONAL UNDER 20 AND UNDER 23 CHAMPIONSHIPS**

Congratulations to all the Box Hill athletes who competed with distinction at the national under 20 and under 23 championships in Hobart last weekend. Special congratulations to our national champions: Sarah Grahame won gold in the under 20 3000m steeple with a time of 10:27.8 and

another gold in the 5000m with a time of 17:42.5 Adam Rabone won the national under 23 triple jump title with 15.06m, while Jacinta Lynn cleared 3.90m to win the under 23 pole vault gold. Jacqui Williams also performed brilliantly to win the silver medal in the under 20 vault with 3.60m.
