BOX HILL WINS 4 PREMIERSHIPS!

Box Hill won 4 premierships at the East Region finals at Doncaster on Saturday and will have 5 teams competing in the Association Finals on February 16.

Box Hill clearly won the Men's division 1 premiership despite some strong opposition from St. Kevins. The division 2 competition was much tighter with our team finishing in a tie with St. Stephens Harriers. Since this year the top 2 teams in each division progress to the Association Final there was no "run off" and the Eastern Region premiership is presented jointly to the 2 teams. The under 16 men were dominant and won by a large margin.

The open women's team performed well, despite having a number of team members unavailable and finished in 2nd place just 11 points behind St. Stephens Harriers. We expect that we will be able to field a stronger team on February 16. The under 18 women's team had a huge win of almost 100 points, while the under 14 girls did well to finish 3rd with a limited number of athletes.
