OPENING OF STROMLO FOREST PARK CROSS COUNTRY CIRCUIT, CANBERRA

In January 2003, a devastating fire that swept across Canberra completely destroyed the Stromlo Forest. After the fires, the ACT Government Bushfire Recovery Taskforce was established. One of the recommendations from the Taskforce was to establish a world-class multi-use, recreational sporting facility available to both recreational and professional users. From this simple beginning, Stromlo Forest Park now boasts a one-of-a-kind community facility with exceptional infrastructure for a variety of users.

The new groomed grass cross country circuit at Stromlo Forest Park will be ready to open on the 18th of November 2007, with the feature events being the elite mens and womens 8km races. It is proposed that the event will become an annual event bringing together the best distance runners in Australia.

Australia's elite athletes will be invited to compete in a men's and women's 8 kilometre cross country races. Prize money for the event will be 1st \$2000, 2nd \$1000, 3rd \$750, 4th \$500, 5th \$250 for both men and women and perpetual trophies will be created for the events. Fields of between 50 and 100 athletes are anticipated in year one and qualifying times will apply. This is aimed at making entry something special that athletes would strive to achieve.

Indicative

qualifying times are

Women 18:00 for 5km or 40:00 for 10km

Men 14:30 for 5km or 31:30 for 10km

The qualifying standard may be easier or harder than these times depending on the number of athletes applying for entry into the events. Athlete enquiries should be made to Dave Hobson d-j-hobson@bigpond.com
