Congratulations to David Stevens who last week completed the 87km Comrades ultramarathon in South Africa. With approximately 11,000 starters (and this year 8,600 finishers inside the 12 hour cut off), the Comrades is the world's biggest ultramarathon. It is run uphill (in even years) from Durban, on the coast to Pietermaritzburg in the mountains. David completed the journey in 10 hours 56 minutes and I believe is the first Box Hill athlete to complete this famous event.
