June's time of 3:42:18 lowered her own 45-49 age group Australian record. June actually passed the marathon distance in 3:03:54 in 6th position. Not to be left out, June's husband, Bert Pelgrim finished third in the half marathon held in conjunction with this event.

WELL DONE STEVE!

After a consistent winter of outstanding performances, Steve Kelly has been crowned the Athletics Victoria Champion winter athlete for 2010. Steve competed in all 6 individual events in the AV cross country and road race series, winning 1 gold, 2 silver and 1 bronze medal. He also finished 4th in the national cross country championships in Brisbane and in so doing won the national under 23 title. Congratulations to Steve on a wonderful series of races.

In the women's competition, Brooke Condon has had a standout season to finish in 6th position and Rachel Johnson finished 9th.

In other categories Julie Norney was crowned the champion in the women's 40-44 age group. John Meagher finished 4th in the men's 45-49 division, June Petrie was 3rd in the women's 45-49 and Bert Pelgrim 4th and Megan Sloane also 4th in the over 50 divisions. Amy Carrig finished the season 2nd in the under 20s, with Grace Brown in 6th and Daniel Balassone 4th in the men's under 20s, while Natalie Ambrose finished in 5th place in the under 18s.
