WINTER SEASON LADDERS

After 6 of the 10 rounds of the XCR'11 season have been completed, Box Hill's men's division 1 team is second on the ladder, just 2 points behind the Geelong Region team. A win at the Sandown relays will put us on top of the ladder (or equal top). Our women's division 1 team is in fourth place and with a chance to move up the ladder with just the relay events and the half marathon to go. Our men's and women's division 2 teams are in 4th and 7th places respectively, with women's division 4 and men's division 5 teams in 7th and 4th places.

In the age group divisions, Box Hill look like winning the premiership in the women's over 40 divisions, with a big lead on top of the ladder. We are also on top of the ladder in the women's U20 and men's U20 competitions, 2nd in the women's U18 and 3rd on the men's over 50 ladder.
