PRESIDENT'S REPORT

The 2011/12 athletic year has been another successful one for the Club, but it has also shown that there are some areas in which the Club can improve its performance.

One of the highlights of the year was a second successive premierships to the Box Hill Women's Division 1 team. This victory was due to a great team effort and was a well deserved triumph for the team.

The Club has also had a growing strength in our junior ranks and closer ties with the Box Hill Little Athletics Centre has had an influence on this.

Box Hill has continued its growing reputation as one of the strongest distance running clubs in the land. Our men finished a close 2nd in the men's Division 1 cross country and road (XCR'11) premierships and our Under 20 men, Under 20 women and our over 40 women all went one better to win the premierships in their divisions.

Box Hill again had international representation, with Steve Dinneen and Steve Kelly selected to represent Australia in the Chiba Ekiden relay team in Japan, Brodie Cross and Paris McCathrion took part in the world youth championships and Kyle Martin-Alcaide being selected for the Commonwealth Youth Games.

Joel Pocklington defended his national pole vault title, while James Filshie and Steve Dinneen also won national medals.

Box Hill athletes picked up an amazing 83 medals at open underage and overage state championships.

Congratulations and thanks also to our coaches who are the backbone of our club and a strong force behind the success of our athletes.

The social side of the club continues to develop with the club 5k handicap being both a social and athletic event used to launch the winter season. A successful summer season launch was held at the club rooms and the Trivia Night and the Presentation Night continue to be main events on the club's calendar.

The club continued to raise funds through the sale of hoodies and socks and through Bunnings BBQs, thanks largely to the work of Leana Joyce and June Petrie. June has also worked to raise the profile of our junior winter team through Saucony prize packs and a Junior Development Fund to help cover the cost of entry fees.

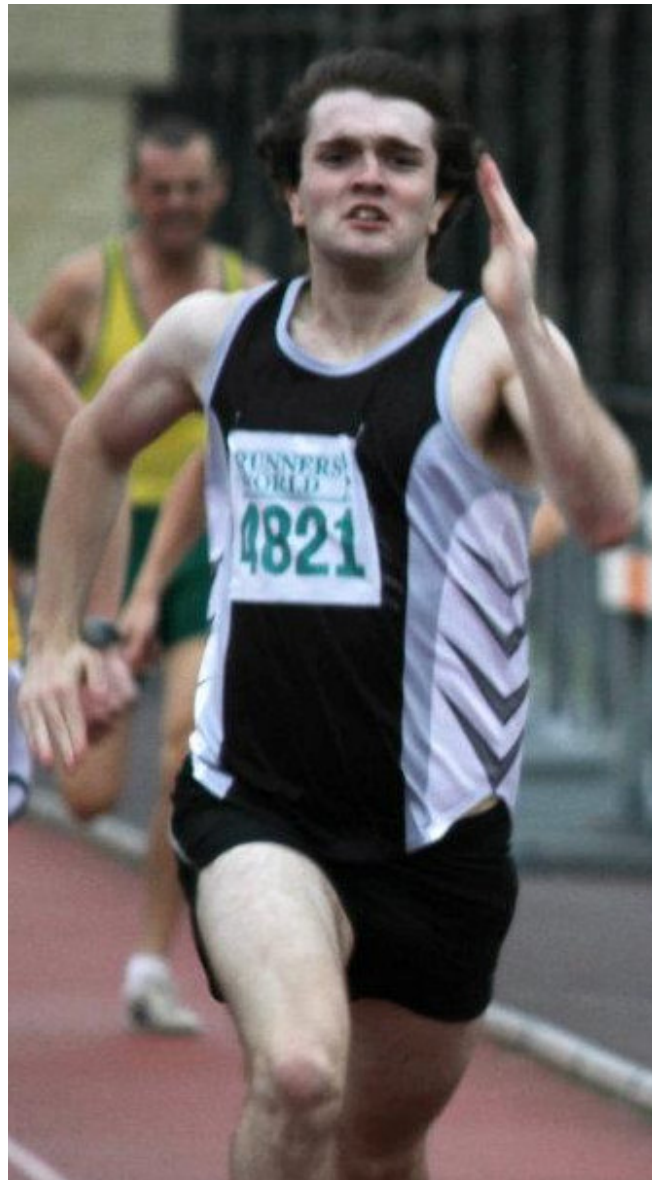
A big development in the administration of the club has been the establishment of the Box Hill Athletics Centre Management Committee. This is a joint committee of the Box Hill Athletic Club and the Box Hill Little Athletics Centre that will use ground hire fees to develop and maintain the track and facilities.

My first year as President of the Club has been more challenging than I expected but I have been lucky to have been supported by an extremely capable and hard working committee. My thanks to the tireless efforts of our committee, Barbara Johnson, Graeme Olden, Colin Organ, Angela Robbie, David Hamer, David Stevens, Blake Lucas, James Filshie, Bill Dyer, our ground manager Tony Marsh and our registrar Nicole Clowes.

I must make special mention to our outgoing Treasurer, Angela Robbie. Angela has been the club's only Treasurer since the men's and women's clubs amalgamated to form the Box Hill Athletic Club in 1996. Her efforts have played a large part in transforming the financial situation of the club to its present strong position. The club's ability to take out two large loans to redevelop the club rooms and then the track and to repay these loans ahead of time may not have been possible without Angela's expertise.

Finally it must be mentioned that this year marks the 80th anniversary of the club. To not just survive but to thrive for 80 years is a great achievement and tribute should be paid to all those who have over the years contributed their time and efforts to the success of the club. Box Hill is a large and diverse club, made up of members of all ages and abilities, with different personalities and motivations. To become successful and remain successful requires not just many hours of work by volunteers but also cooperation and goodwill of all members working for the common good.

TREASURER'S REPORT

This financial year a net surplus of \$37,610.76 has been achieved. This is a fantastic result and \$15,000.00 up on last year.

Approximately \$14,500.00 was spent on equipment, repairs and maintenance. All purchases, repairs and maintenance are for the enjoyment and benefit of members. It is also very pleasing to note that there is now only \$20,572.10 owing on the loan and in fact the loan could be repaid in full from the Club's assets, leaving the Club debt free.

Membership decreased slightly and so did ground hire income. The decrease in ground hire income was mainly due to AV not paying for shield competition. Agreement was reached with AV that they would receive two years free shield competition in exchange for the Olympic Park pole vault pit and stands. Every effort should be made to attract new hirers and ensure current hirers are happy with the service provided and the standard of the ground.

The BHAC in conjunction with BHLAC again operated the canteen with the help of a Canteen Manager and this proved profitable with approximately \$9,600.00 being raised.

Many donations were made direct to the Club, through the Barlow Fund or the Australian Sports Foundation and I thank all those that contributed in this way.

Approximately \$6,500.00 was raised through fundraising activities which included the Trivia night, the Bunnings BBQ and BBQ's at school meets. The fund raising activities were a huge success and the funds raised have been spent on equipment, and further development of the track. Thanks to all members who chipped in and helped with fundraising activities.

With the development of the Box Hill Athletics Centre Management Committee (BHACMC) the Club accounts will now take a new direction. All funds in the Ground Hire Account and Canteen Account will be transferred to BHACMC and that committee will now be responsible for all ground hire, maintenance and capital works improvements at Hagenauer's Reserve.

It is with some sadness that I write this report as it will be my last report as Treasurer. After 2 years as Treasurer of the Women's Club and 16 years as Treasurer of BHAC I feel it is time for me to step away from this position. I would like to thank all club members and committee members, past and present that have provided support to me over such a long period of time. I wish the new Treasurer and the Club all the best in future years.

After 8 consecutive premierships, our men's division 1 team has finished 2nd, 3rd and 5th in the past 3 years. It is important that we reverse this trend and put our men's team back on top where it belongs.

A big measure of our success can be seen by the huge number of Box Hill athletes who won state championship medals over the full range of age groups. Congratulations to our state open champions, Rebecca Marchant, Daniel Clark, Joel Pocklington, Julie Norney and Simone Carre and to all our junior and overage champions.

2011 Winter Season (XCR'11)

Box Hill continued its rise as one of Victoria's distance running powers with another successful Winter season. At the conclusion of the XCR'11 season Box Hill secured three premierships and finished 2nd or 3rd in a number of other divisions. Congratulations to our Under 20 men, Under 20 women and Over 40 women who all won their division premierships for 2011. Box Hill finished 2nd on the ladder in Men's Division 1, 2nd in women's Under 18 and 3rd in men's Over 50. Well done to all the athletes who competed for the club over the winter season.

Box Hill has had an increasing number of runners taking part in the winter events over the past several years and this has led to greater success and greater excitement throughout the winter season.

Steve Kelly was again named the Athletics Victoria Champion Winter Athlete. Judged on the best 5 placings from the six individual XCR'11 events, not only did Steve win for the second year in a row, but Box Hill had 3 athletes in the top 10 with Steve Dinneen finishing 3rd and Chris Hamer in 7th place. In other divisions, Brooke Condon finished 8th in the women's championship, Megan Sloane, Julie Norney and June Petrie all finished 2nd in their age groups, while Bert Pelgrim (4th), John Meagher (5th) Chris O'Connor (7th) and Amanda Harper (10th) all placed well in their respective masters divisions.

In the junior divisions Grace Brown won the women's Under 20 Victorian Winter Champion award, Michael Dowel who finished 2nd in the men's under 20 championship while Amy Carrig (U20), Natalie Ambrose (U18) and Zoe Schwerkolt (U14) who all finished 3rd in their age groups. Kyle Martin-Alcaide finished 2nd in the national under 18 cross country championship.

On the international scene, Steve Kelly and Steve Dinneen were selected in the Australian team that travelled to Chiba, Japan for the Ekiden relay and June Petrie qualified to take part in the world 50km championships.

The other successful Box Hill winter athlete was race walker Nathan Brill. Nathan won a number of titles including the national under 16 5km road event

After a successful 2011 season and with many of our under 20 athletes moving up to the open ranks we look forward with great expectation to the 2012 season.
