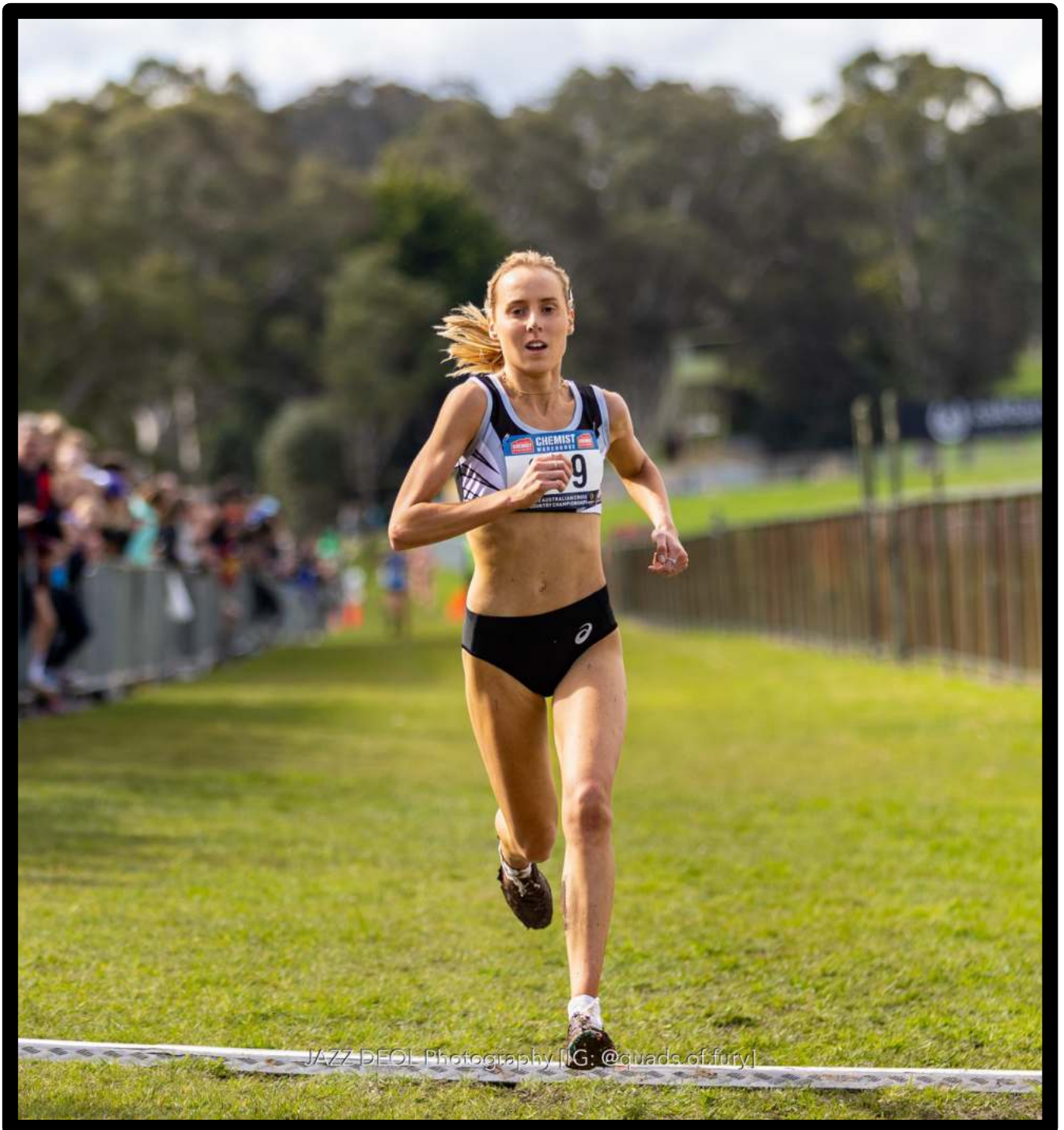

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

I am pleased to present the President's Report for the 2022/23 year, celebrating another successful year for our athletic club.

Finances:

Our club's financial status remains strong, with our reserves peaking at over \$90,000. Our events, the Box Hill Classic and Box Hill Burn, with the addition of our sponsors and donors have been key in ensuring we have a solid financial base.

Sponsors:

As mentioned, we are delighted to have gained strong sponsors such as Tradetech Service Australia, Bendigo Bank, Athletics International, and Bread Street. Their support has been invaluable to our club's success.

Pacing Lights:

We are in the process of procuring pacing lights, making us the first track in Australia to possess this advanced technology. These lights will elevate the running experience for our athletes, setting a new standard in Australia.

Capital Works:

Through numerous grants, current reserves and donations, the Club is currently installing new lighting (\$400,000), shade shelters (\$80,000), as well as new pacing lights (\$55,000). As you will be aware over the last couple of years, we have purchased new pole vault mats, completed terracing improvements, installed main straight lighting, and upgraded the gym.

Fundraising Efforts:

Our fundraising efforts have yielded excellent results, allowing us to help fund many of our improvements. We encourage everyone to support these initiatives through simple tax-deductible donations via the Australian Sports Foundation.

Winter Report 2022

After the cancellation of many winter events throughout 2020 and 2021, we thankfully had a full season of cross country and road racing in 2022. Our men's and women's premier division teams both performed well finishing second and third respectively, but unfortunately missing out on the premierships. Our Under 16 boys were, however, victorious winning the winter teams premiership, thanks to the performances of Campbell Brooks, Kalan Luong, Jack Ewison, Andre Maillardet and Fabiano Aguiard.

Throughout the season there were some great team performances with wins by the women in the season opening cross country relays at Jells Park and by the men in the Sandown road relays.

There were also many outstanding individual performances, most notably by Georgia Hansen, who won the women's 8km and 12km cross country championships as well as the 10km road championship. She then went on to a brilliant victory in the national cross country championship in Canberra. Melissa Duncan also had a great winter season, finishing second to Georgia twice, before winning the state 10km cross country championship and the Victorian half-marathon championship (in her first attempt at the distance!).

Andre Waring picked up several medals before being victorious in the state 15km road race championship around Lake Wendouree in Ballarat. His consistent performances meant that Andre won the individual winter champion athlete award. With three victories and one second place, from the four events that she contested, Amelie Alleva, in her debut season, was the Victorian Under 20 winter champion and also picked up a medal in the national championships.

Campbell Brooks won one gold and two silver medals as named the Under 16 winter champion athlete.

Doug Buckeridge also had a great winter season, winning several medals in the Under 20 age group and stepping up and performing extremely well in the open team when needed.

Box Hill athletes also performed well at the Victorian All Schools cross country championships at Bundoora, with Sophie Hall winning the Under 14 title, while Kalan Luong (U16) and Khushi Deol (U16) both won bronze medals.

In the masters events, Julie Norney was again outstanding becoming the Over 50 winter champion and John Meagher was the best performed athlete in the Over 55 years category. Pia Hunter and Kerry Putt finished first and second respectively in the women's Over 50 short course category.

Thank you to all the athletes who competed so well in the 2022 winter season and thank you to all the parents and helpers who assisted throughout the season. A special mention to Ian Sloane and Megan Sloane who again provided invaluable help and support again this year.

Let's hope for even greater success in 2023.

Summer Report 2022/23 Track and Field Season

Although it was slightly disappointing to see Box Hill finishing sixth in the Athletics Victoria Shield League (AVSL), this year, it has become obvious over the past few years that the current interclub system does not appeal to all members. This is especially true with the proliferation of other events that are being held each year. Nevertheless, Box Hill has a proud tradition of success in interclub team competition and we thank those members who scored points for the club in AVSL and look forward to better results in 2023/24.

It was, however, a highly successful track and field season for Box Hill. The incredible achievements of our members can be seen by the fact that Box Hill athletes won more than 120 state championship medals.

Box Hill athletes also had some outstanding results at the national championships. Special mention to Ellie Sanford and Andre Waring, who both ran personal best times to take a medal at national championships.

On the international stage Georgia Griffith ran a brilliant 4:00.16 over 1500m in Rabat, Morocco to earn a place in the World Championships in Eugene, Oregon where she finished 9th in the final. Georgia was also selected for the Birmingham Commonwealth Games where she ran a near PB of 2:00.36.

Tom Diamond also represented Australian the under 20 world championships in Colombia, while Andre Waring and Georgia Hansen earned places in the Australian team for the World Cross Country Championships that were held in Bathurst.
